Although the Internet is a wonderful source of information, it is also a source of danger. While no one knows for sure how many teenagers are addicted to the Internet, psychologist Kimberly S. Young of the Center for Online Addiction believes that between 5 and 10 percent of Internet users have problems controlling their Internet habits.
